## Application for Membership • Student

Phi Beta Delta recognizes high scholastic achievement of international and U.S. students. Students may be nominated for membership by faculty or staff or may apply directly. Cost of induction is \$35 (a one-time fee), and yearly dues are \$25.

### Credit Hours

Juniors and seniors with a minimum of 30 credit hours earned at KU and graduate student applicants with a minimum of 12 credit hours earned at KU prior to their induction into chapter membership are eligible to apply.

### Grade Point Average

- Undergraduate applicants must have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.25.
- Graduate applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.5; Law School applicants must have a GPA of 3.3.
- Exchange students who have outstanding academic records at their home institutions are not subject to the minimum credit hour requirement.

### U.S. Students and Permanent Residents

Must have studied abroad or conducted research abroad or have had a comparable international experience and/or have been actively involved in promoting international understanding through their extracurricular (outside the classroom) activities at the University of Kansas or in other academic settings.

### International Students

Must have demonstrated interest and commitment to international understanding by their extracurricular (outside the classroom) activities at the University of Kansas. International students must be non-immigrant visa holders.

Note: Individuals with international experience of merit differing from the conditions specified above may also be considered for membership.
